### Why are Cabin Air Filters Important?

Researchers have determined that the great indoors may contain some of the most polluted air in the world. In a more compact environment like your vehicle's interior cabin, there may be a high concentration of dust, pollen, and other unwelcome air particles. Such particles can potentially affect the comfort and health of driver and passenger alike, and aggravate allergies.

### When Should They Be Replaced?

You should be aware that environmental driving conditions will affect the product life of a Cabin Air Filter. Driving in heavy traffic, urban or dusty environments, or on dirt roads may shorten the filter's life. Filter replacement may be needed if reduced air flow is observed from the air conditioner and heater or if the windows fog-up easily in the FRESH mode. Consult your local dealer if any of these conditions occur and check your vehicle's Scheduled Maintenance Guide for replacement intervals.
